### 'Air-mazing Christ Church Primary!'

You might have seen or heard about an air quality project at Christ Church school over the next 6 months. It's part of a project happening in 10 schools across Lambeth, learning about air pollution, and what we can do about it. It's being delivered by Holly from the charity Sustrans.

#### *What's going on?*

We'll be putting up 'diffusion tubes' around the school to measure Nitrogen Dioxide (NO<sub>2</sub>), and we'll also measure PM<sub>10</sub> (very small particles) using hand held monitors. We'll plan cleaner routes with the children and organise car-free days to see if the air is cleaner at the school gates.
