A LETTER FOR PARENTS WITH PUPILS IN YEARS 4, 5 & 6
RE: WALKING HOME ALONE AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Children are unable to walk home unsupervised, unless written permission from a Parent or Guardian has been received. This is to keep the children safe and to enable us to know exactly how they are getting home.

If you choose to let their child travel to/from school independently, then we ask you to assess the risks associated with the school route and your own child's confidence.

If you wish allow your child to walk home alone, please sign below and leave your contact number. Children will ONLY be able to walk home alone once this has been received.

Once children have left the school premises they are your responsibility.

As a school, we do not recommend older children take home their siblings in KS1.
