## Household Support

The household support scheme helps Lambeth Residents that are facing hardship, a crisis, emergency, or disaster. This includes struggling to pay bills or afford food.

We can help with vouchers for food or high street shops, fuel payments, handyman services, removals and storage along with physical goods such as refurbished white goods and second-hand furniture.

## Post Office payout

Lambeth households who do not pay their council tax via Direct Debit should have received a letter via the post to claim their council tax energy rebate, simply take this letter with a form of ID to any Post Office branch. Households in receipt of Council Tax Support will have received an additional payout.

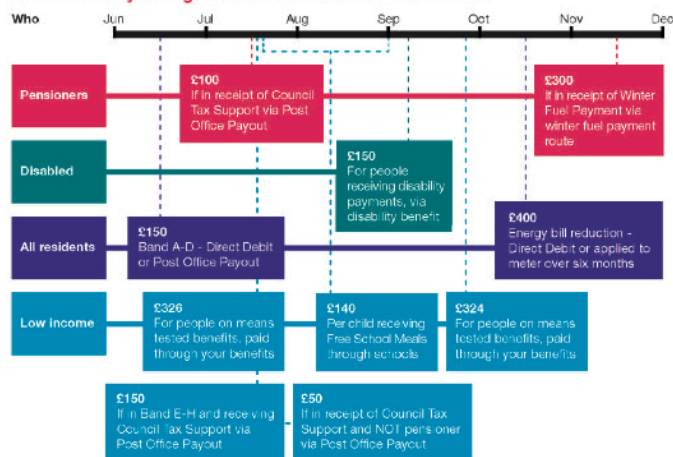

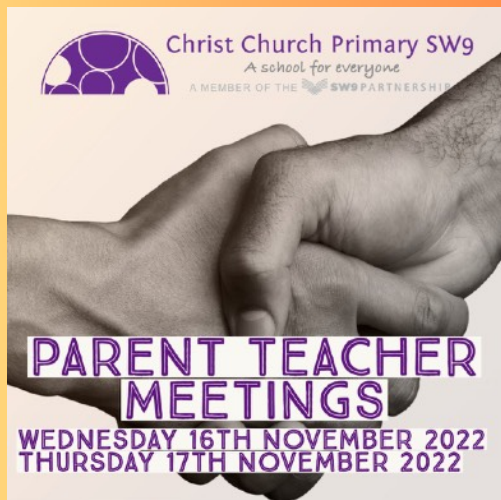
