person you need a bit quicker!



75 YEARS OF THE WINDRUSH GENERATION

On 21 June 1948, a ship called HMT *Empire Windrush* docked at Tilbury in Essex after arriving from Jamaica.

It carried 1,027 passengers including men, women and children who gave their last country of residence as somewhere in the Caribbean. They were travelling to the United Kingdom hoping to start a new life. Marking the date of disembarkation, Windrush Day takes place on 22 June each year.

Windrush was not the first ship to carry a large group of West Indian people to the United Kingdom, as two other ships had arrived the previous year. But Windrush's 1948 voyage has become very well-known and we are looking forward to celebrating 75 years of the Windrush Generation.

On Thursday 22nd June children are invited to come to school dressed as Windrush passengers. Suits, ties, hats, headscarves, dresses, gloves anything goes. Here are a few pictures for inspiration.

There will be other activities on the actual day and an art competition. We hope that you will all take part!
