

 s	Shove your teeth and let the s hiss out ssssss sssss	c se ce st sl sc
 n	Close your lips a bit and your tongue behind your teeth and make the nnnnnn sound nnnnnn	kn gn
 m	Put your lips together and make the mmmmmm sound mmmmmm	mb
 c	Open your mouth into a little smile, make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say ccc	ch
 r	Shove your teeth to make a rrrrrr sound rrrrrr	rr
 f	Open your lips a little and your teeth on your bottom lip and push the air out to make the sound ffff ffff	ph
 t	Open your mouth a little and your tongue up to the top of your mouth behind your teeth, and press ttt ttt	te st
 j	Pusher your lips and shove your teeth, use your tongue as you say jjj	g dip ge
 v	Put your teeth against your bottom lip and make a buzzing sound vvvv vvvv	ve

 z	Shove your teeth and buzz the z sound zzzz zzzz	ze zz

 sh	Shove your teeth and push the air out shshshshsh	ch ti ad ai di
 e	Open your mouth wide and say eee	ee
 l	Put your lips back and make the l sound at the back of your mouth lll	yl
 o	Make your mouth into a round shape and say ooo	o
 u	Open your mouth wide and say uuu	u-u o-oo

*Note that the pronunciation of 'ture' has a slight schwa sound at the end.


