Topic


- Our topic for this term is Parklife.



- Homework will be given out on Friday (starting this week).

- Weekly spelling tests. Spellings are on a 2-week basis, so pupils will be taking home the same set of words for two weeks.
- We will be giving the pupils weekly spelling and times table tests.
- TTRockstars there is a website online that children will have log ins for. It is a great resources to practice times tables.
- We encourage you to read for 15 minutes a day with your pupil.

Behaviour

- We have high expectations of behaviour,
- We have a point system (Dojo points).
- Every pupil starts the day on green (1 dojo) and can move up to silver (3 dojos) and gold (5 dojos). They can also move down to yellow (no dojos) and red (missing some of break to reflect on their behaviour).
