You are invited to the PTA AGM on Friday 2 February at 9.05 in the school hall.


We will be voting a new committee (chair, vice-chair, treasurer and secretary) as well as nominating new class reps.

Support the school and create lasting memories

The PTA is vital to the success of the school. Funds raised enrich your child's learning and help to make every student's experience better. Our children are only at primary school for a few years, but they will remember that experience for a lifetime. Be part of the group that organises activities and funds useful resources to create special memories for all our wonderful children.

Its flexible: Whether you are a full-time parent or working 9-5 there are lots of different ways to get involved. Small jobs such as designing a poster, distributing flyers, running a stall at an event, baking a cake, donating prizes, all help make things run smoothly and raise money.

Have fun, make friends, be better connected

Meet and chat to a wider circle of families from different year groups. Get to know other parents and get a greater sense of belonging to our school community. If you're new to the school the PTA is an excellent way to meet staff and find out how things work from the school and parents' point of view.

Share and learn new skills: Everyone has something they can bring to the PTA and you can also gain new skills by learning from others. We have a diverse group of parents and carers, an immense and rich pool of talent and experience from which we can all draw on, contribute to and learn from.

Improve your child's learning: Studies show that children whose parents who are involved in their education do better in school. Engaging with the PTA shows your children that their school and education are important to you.

The Committee

The CHAIR oversees the organisation, promotion, and delivery of all our activities and events. They work in close collaboration with the school and encourage participation from all at Christ Church.

The VICE CHAIR supports the chair in organising and running events, liaises with the class reps to ensure we have volunteers to help out and that key information is shared widely.

The TREASURER deals with the cash. Prepares 'floats' for events, collects the money, keeps track of and reports on funds raised, manages the bank account and relevant documentation.

The SECRETARY handles the PTA correspondence, ensures we operate in line with our constitution, organises meetings, prepares agendas, takes, and circulates minutes.

The CLASS REPS (x2 per class):

- Share information about events in person and via the WhatsApp group.
- Recruit volunteers to support specific activities.
- Collect ideas from parents and feed them into the year's activity plan.
- They also share info from the school newsletter and relevant sources.
- Keep our community updated and in the loop.

Class reps will be the first in line to volunteer at events and activities and be positive ambassadors for our school.



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
