Thank you to everyone who made an effort for Number Day last week. We raised over £90 for the NSPCC.



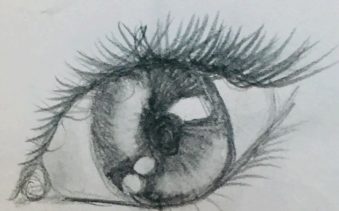

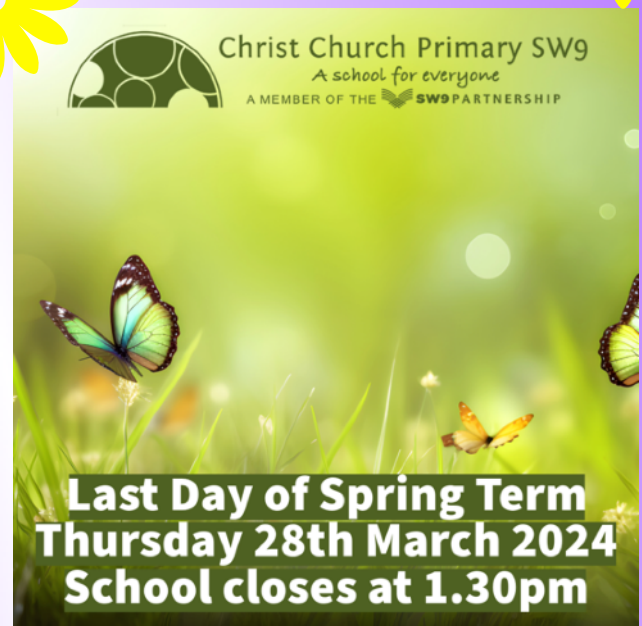
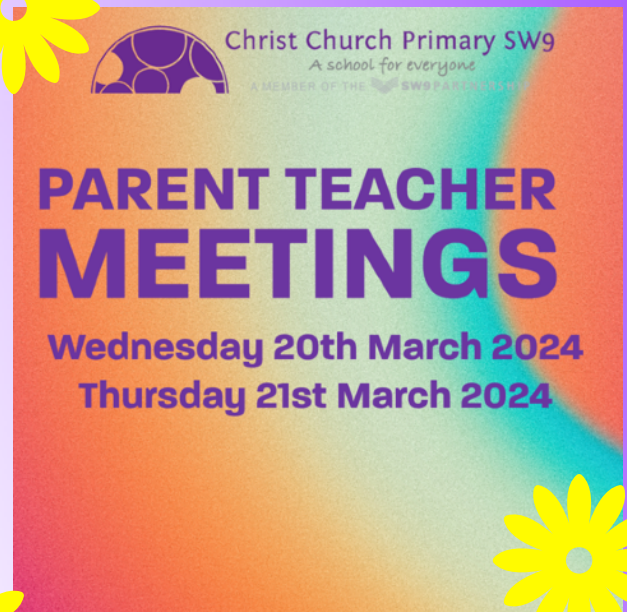
If you have an idea of an activity or event that YOU would be happy to lead on, then get in touch with your class representative.

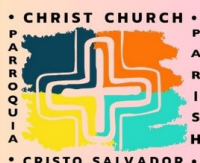
