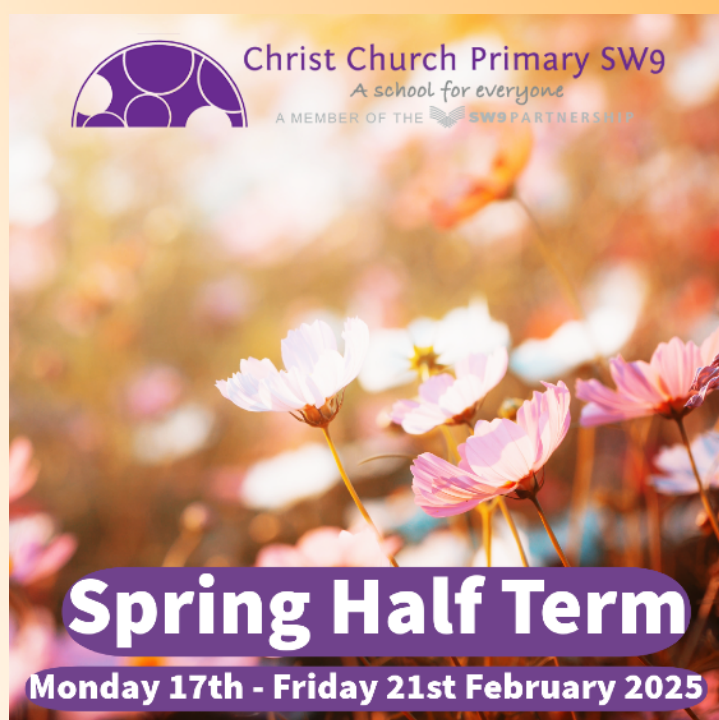


Attendees at Always Club this week are:

TikTok



- 1 Become familiar with the age restrictions that Tik Tok has in place for sharing content.
- 2 The Tik Tok algorithm determines what recommended videos appear in your "for you" section.
- 3 Be on the lookout for ideas and challenges that go viral on Tik Tok, some can be dangerous in nature.
- 4 Take advantage of parental controls for time limits of Tik Tok use and content filters.
- 5 Consider sharing an account so that you are familiar with the content being viewed and shared.

Please remember that social media platforms impose age restrictions for valid reasons.

These safeguards are designed to protect our children from content and interactions that may be beyond their emotional and cognitive readiness.

So let's keep our children safe together and please do not hesitate to talk to us if you have any concerns.

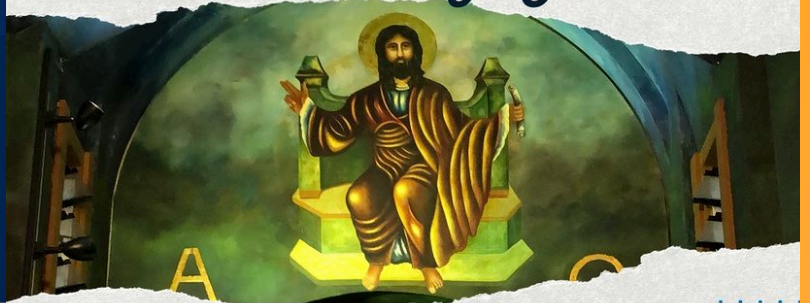
