## SCHOOL UNIFORM

Thank you for making every effort to ensure your children are wearing the correct school uniform. They all look so smart coming in to school in the morning!

To remind you:

- All children should be wearing black shoes. Trainers, Crocs or soft canvas footwear are not permitted.
- No jewellery, other than plain stud earrings, is permitted - this is for health and safety reasons. Necklaces, chains, hoop earrings and bracelets can easily be pulled and could cause injury.
- Nail varnish and lip gloss are not permitted!
- All children should have a school PE kit, that is a white t-shirt with the school logo and navy blue shorts or jogging bottoms. Children should not wear branded sports clothing.
