

## PUNCTUALITY and ATTENDANCE

Thank you to all families for ensuring your children attend school regularly and are always on time. We know that regular attendance and good punctuality of pupils is critical if children are to have the very best learning experience. We want to work in partnership with all our families to ensure that our children achieve to their full potential and make maximum progress.

Therefore, we expect an attendance rate of at least 96% each year - this leaves a little time off just in case of illness. If your child's attendance is below 90% then your child is classed as a 'persistent absentee' by the local authority and this could result in a referral to the education welfare service.
