Thursday 8th October 2026

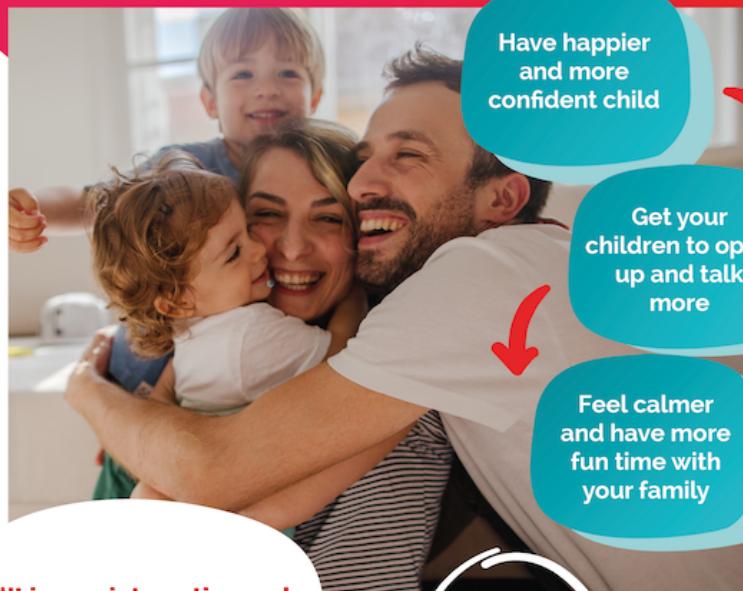
